



**RESOLUTION No. 6-2020**

**ESTABLISHING REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM PERFORMANCE TARGETS**

**WHEREAS**, the Chelan-Douglas Transportation Council (CDTC) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization and the Regional Transportation Planning Organization with responsibility for transportation planning and programming in the Wenatchee Metropolitan Statistical Area encompassing Chelan County and Douglas County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Act (MAP-21) established a performance-based planning framework for state departments of transportation, such as the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT), transit providers, such as LINK Transit, and metropolitan planning organizations, such as the Chelan Douglas Transportation Council (CDTC); and


**WHEREAS**, MAP-21 implementing regulations provide the framework for coordinating measures and targets amongst state departments of transportation, metropolitan planning organizations, and transit providers for tracking the performance of highway safety, infrastructure condition, and travel time reliability; and transit asset management and safety; and

**WHEREAS**, in establishing regional performance targets per 23 CFR 490.105(f)(3), CDTC has the option to either determine its own quantifiable targets for each performance measure, or agree to statewide targets; and

**WHEREAS**, in establishing transit asset management and safety targets, CDTC is required to coordinate with LINK Transit in the selection of MPO performance targets Per 49 CFR 625.45(e) and 49 CFR 673.15(b);

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CDTC GOVERNING BOARD** that the Chelan-Douglas Transportation Council hereby agrees to establish regional performance targets that are consistent with WSDOT statewide targets as currently defined and as they may change over time for highway safety, infrastructure condition, and travel time reliability; and to establish performance targets for transit asset management and safety, consistent with targets defined by LINK Transit.
